Corporate pilot didn't let his weight bring him down

Terry Kelly had always been active, but as he grew older, he got heavier. It became increasingly difficult to do the things he loved like running, cycling and tennis. Then an annual physical – a requirement for all pilots – showed Kelly was in the beginning stages of diabetes. "Diabetes can be a death sentence for a pilot's career. I was scared. This is a job I love and it's how I support my family."

Like many heavy people, Kelly's weight had been a rollercoaster most of his adult life. When the scale hit 355 pounds, he started looking for other options. After having weight loss surgery at Baptist Center for Bariatric Surgery in May 2016, he's lost more than 100 pounds.

Craig Morgenthal, MD, and Steven Hodgett, MD, at the Baptist Center for Bariatric Surgery perform three types of weight loss surgery - gastric banding, gastric bypass and sleeve gastrectomy, which is what Kelly had. Not only is the Baptist Center for Bariatric Surgery an accredited center with fellowship-trained surgeons, Baptist offers free informational seminars, free insurance verification, and does not charge a program fee.

Kelly said he's more self-confident now and feels much better. He doesn't need to take six pain relievers a day for joint pain and no longer sleeps with a C-PAP machine for sleep apnea. Best of all, his pilot's license is no longer in jeopardy since he is no longer considered pre-diabetic.

"I thought having surgery would be admitting failure," said Kelly. "I had to let go of that. I realized that continuing to live my life at 350 pounds was more of a risk than having the surgery. I wish I would have done this 10 years ago."

The Breast Screening and Prevention Clinic at Baptist MD Anderson is designed to provide a personalized and comprehensive risk evaluation in addition to a thorough clinical breast exam to individuals concerned about their risk for breast cancer.

Once this assessment has taken place, the team will determine the patient's true risk percentage and design an individualized imaging surveillance plan that includes risk reduction strategies. The results and recommendations will be shared with the referring physician before an individualized surveillance plan is proposed.





